

Optum Idaho Audit Tool Scoring

The scores are obtained from the audit tools used during the Optum Idaho review process:

- Organizational Provider Site Audit Tool
- Treatment Record Review Form
- Adult Community Based Rehabilitation Services Treatment Record Review
- Youth Community Based Rehabilitation Services Treatment Record Review
- Peer Support Site Audit Tool
- Peer Support Record Review Tool
- Clinician Site Audit Tool

The overall score for the following tools are obtained by averaging the scores for each applicable member treatment record reviewed during the review process. These tools include:

- Treatment Record Review Form
- Adult Community Based Rehabilitation Services Treatment Record Review
- Youth Community Based Rehabilitation Services Treatment Record Review
- Peer Support Record Review Tool

Scores of 85% or higher on all audit tools are considered passing.

A score below 85% on one or more audit tools results in a request for the provider to submit a corrective action plan addressing each deficiency identified during the review.

A score below 80% on one or more audit tools requires submission of a corrective action plan and results in a re-review within 4–6 months following the implementation of the corrective action plan. The re-review will be a full review, with a focus on the items that were subject to the corrective action plan. You will be contacted to schedule this review.
